

Jasminum multipartitum



JASMINUM MULTIPARTITUM

Vigorous evergreen with a bushy or climbing habit, native to southern Africa, it can reach up to 3 meters in height. It is highly branched from the base and has a dense and compact appearance, bearing small, dark green, elliptical leaves that serve as a backdrop for a profuse flowering from late spring to early summer (June-August). The latter is composed of large, pure white flowers intensely fragrant, and whose corolla can reach up to 12 petals. The buds, on the other hand, are characteristically tinted with red and are also decorative.

Although it tolerates full sun, it prefers and develops better in conditions of partial shade. It needs rich and fertile, perfectly drained soils. It tolerates drought, but it benefits from occasional summer irrigation; it regularly benefits from the addition of abundant organic material. After flowering, it can be pruned to contain its growth or to improve its compact form. In addition to full field, the plant gives excellent results in containers and is highly decorative even in the months in which it is without flowers.
