It is an oliv variety widespread in central-eastern Sicily. Of high vigor. Partly self-fertile, it benefits from the pollination of Moresca, Ogliarola Messinese, Tonda Iblea, Zaituna. Productivity is high but alternating. The oil is of high quality.
